Dear Families

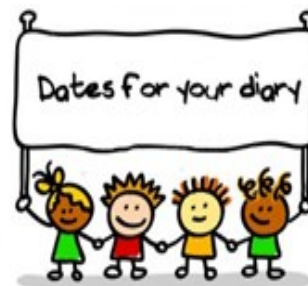
We are now into the final half term of the school year, which is traditionally very busy, although we usually manage to fit everything in!
