<p>Super me We are all unique and have our own super qualities. If you could be any superhero, what superhero would you be? Draw a picture of yourself as this superhero and explain why you would be them.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u> Children will receive spellings each week. These should be practised using the Look, Cover, Write and Check strategy. The children should then write sentences to apply these spellings.</p>	<p>Addition and Subtraction. Pick 2 numbers and choose to either add them or subtract them. Don't forget you can use resources around you to help find the answer. </p>
<p>A significant person  This half term we are looking at famous people that have made an impact on society. Choose a famous person to research and find out what made them significant. Here is some inspiration – Neil Armstrong, Rosa Parks, Queen Elizabeth etc.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> Children should be reading for ten minutes each night. Please initial in their planner so that we can reward them with a star. Children are encouraged to change their own books but if this isn't happening we are happy to remind them.</p>	<p>3D shape hunt  How many 3D shapes can you find around you? Spot the 3D shapes and challenge yourself to write down the properties of these shapes.</p>
<p>Let's get designing!  Every superhero needs a fantastic outfit to wear. We would like you to design a new superhero outfit. What materials would you use?</p>	<p>Super description  Choose a superhero and describe what they look like. You may like to pick a superhero you already know or design your own. Don't forget to think about what they are wearing etc. Challenge yourself to include an expanded noun phrase.</p>	<p>Number bonds to 10/20 We have been busy learning all about our number bonds to 10. How many can you write down? Challenge yourself to write down write down number bonds to 20.</p>
<p>A waterproof outfit We need your help choosing a material to make an outfit that is waterproof. Pick some materials and test whether they are waterproof.</p>	<p>Let's write a story Imagine you are in a superhero story. What would you be doing? Who would you save? Have a go at writing a simple story. Think about the beginning, middle and end.</p>	<p>Patterns Pick some 2D shapes to create a pattern. Draw your pattern in your homework book. Challenge yourself to make a pattern using 3 or more shapes.</p>
<p>Special stories In Religious Education we are looking at stories that are important. Choose a story that is important to you. Draw the front cover and write a sentence to explain why it is important.</p>	<p>English activities you might like to practise:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forming and joining letters neatly. • Writing the days of the week and months of the year. • Phonics knowledge using the links on our website. 	<p>Maths activities you might like to practise:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognising numbers above 20 (Yr1) or 100 (Yr2). • Counting forwards and backwards in twos, fives and tens. • Know number bonds to ten (pairs of numbers that add up to ten)
