



EYFS and KS1

Autumn 2—2022



As Writers:

In EYFS we will be beginning to form simple sentences using the sounds we have learned so far. We will begin to explore story structure learning about beginnings, middles and endings. In KS1 we will explore pieces of descriptive writing about superheroes and villains. Then, we will look at the narrative Charlie's Superhero Underpants and the different ways that we can retell the story. Finally, we will learn about the different features of newspapers and letters and will be writing our own.

As Readers:

In EYFS we will continue to develop our confidence in learning sounds through our Phonics lessons. We will be working hard to blend these sounds together in order to read words. In KS1 we will be continuing to develop our understanding of what we have read through exploring key texts in our Guided Reading lessons.

As Mathematicians:

In EYFS we will be exploring numbers in many different ways including counting and number recognition. We will also be looking at shapes linked to the number of the week. In KS1 we will be exploring addition and subtraction and will learn different ways of solving questions. We will then move on to developing our knowledge of shapes.

As Historians:

In EYFS we will be comparing pictures of police officers now compared to the past and discussing what we notice. In KS1 we will be exploring real-life Superheroes from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. We will learn about Neil Armstrong and the newspaper articles that covered the moon landing. Then we will learn about Rosa Parks and the impact that she had on society.

As programmers:

In EYFS will be developing our confidence in using technology. We will use Purple Mash to complete simple activities. In KS1 we will be learning how to create simple instructions in order to programme a character to move.

As Designers:

In EYFS we will be exploring using different materials in order to create models. We will be thinking about the best way to join these materials together. In KS1 we will use our knowledge of materials from our science investigations to design, create and make our very own superhero outfit.

As Scientists

In EYFS we will be recognising changes we see in Winter and experimenting with different ways to make ice melt in order to rescue our superheroes. In KS1 we will be exploring the properties of different materials and their uses in a variety of objects. We will then conduct an investigation to find out which materials are waterproof and would therefore be the most suitable for a superhero to wear.

Reminders:
