I will ask permission before using the Internet and use it for a specific purpose.



I will never share my password or personal details, such as my full name or address with anyone.



I will only message, chat to or video-conference with people an adult has approved and never meet up with someone who asks me to on the internet.



I will always check my messages are polite before I send them.



I will not reply to a message that isn't kind, but I will save it and show it to an adult.



I will never post photographs or video clips without permission and never include names with photographs or include identifying features like school uniform.



I will not open or download a file unless I have permission from an adult.



I know I should not believe everything I read on the Internet.



I will always tell an adult if something on the Internet makes me or my friends unhappy.



I will follow all of these rules.
